

Lunar New Year day this year is Tuesday, February 1st.

The Chinese and Vietnamese Zodiacs are represented by 12 animals. According to legend, the Jade Emperor invited all animals to enter a long race and the first 12 to finish would each rule a year every 12 years. The Tiger was the 3rd animal to finish the race, which is why it appears as the third animal in the zodiac.

Each zodiac animal brings its own personality and characteristics to the year. Can you imagine what a tiger year might look like?
